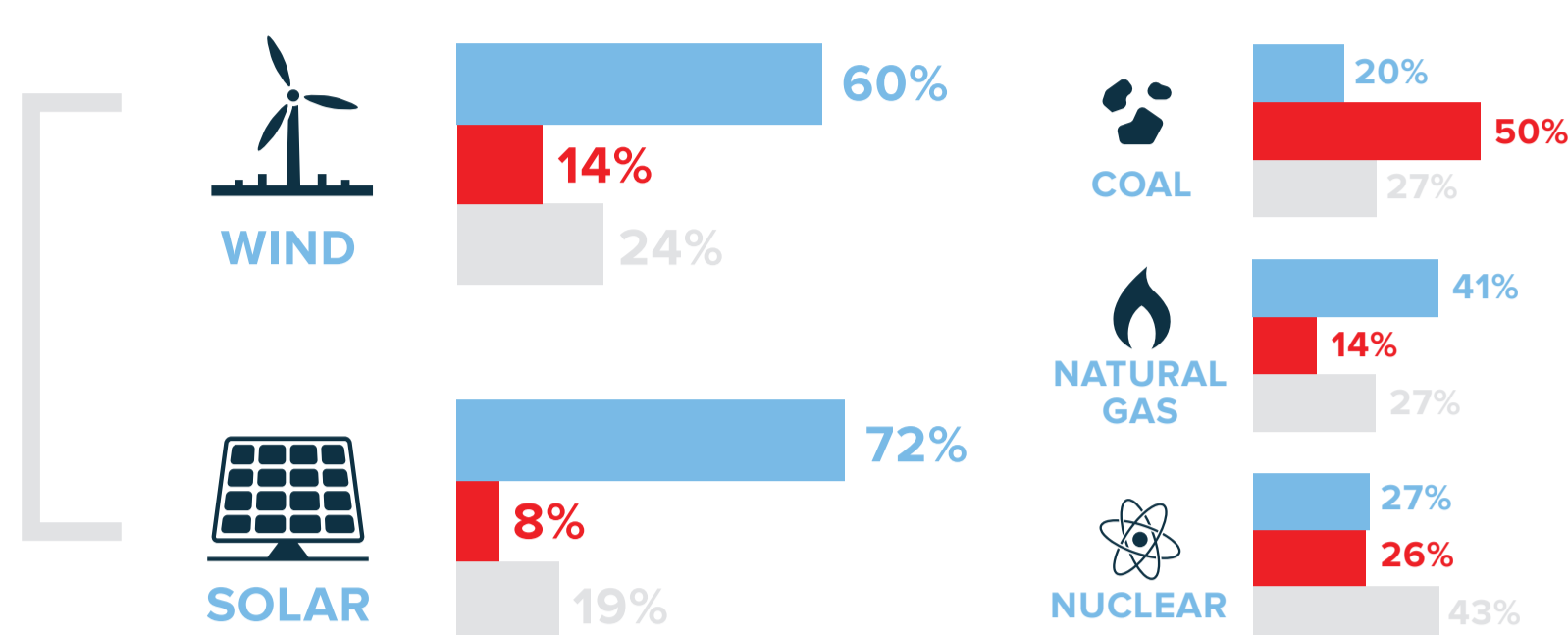

want to accelerate the growth of clean energy in Virginia.

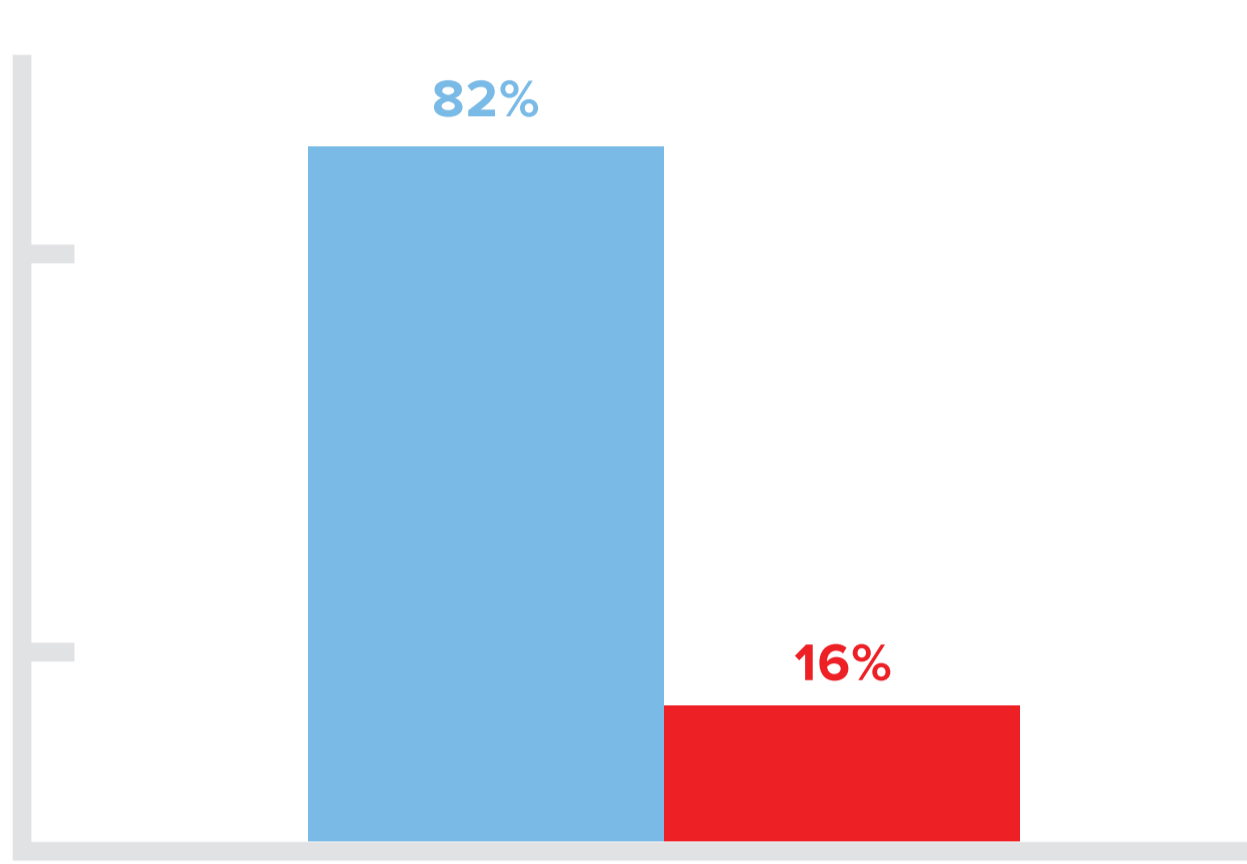
Over 75% of voters would like Virginia to put more emphasis on clean energy.

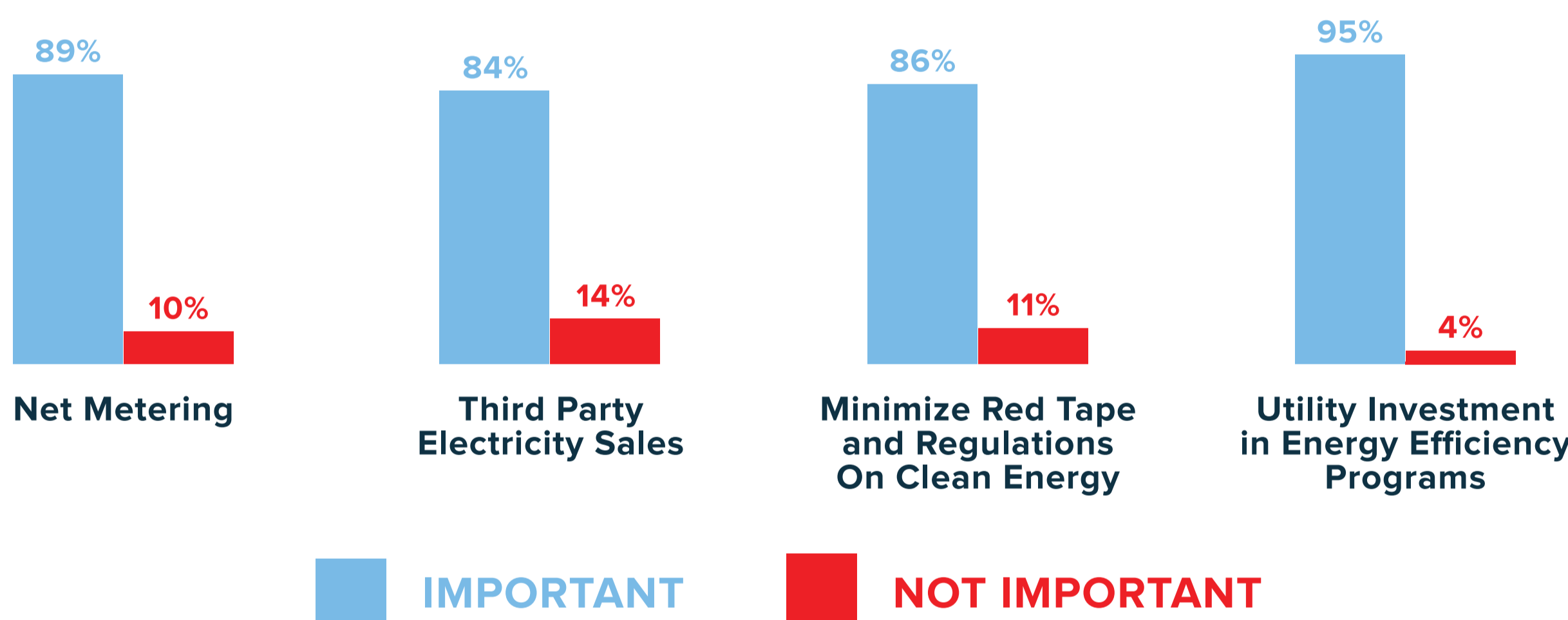

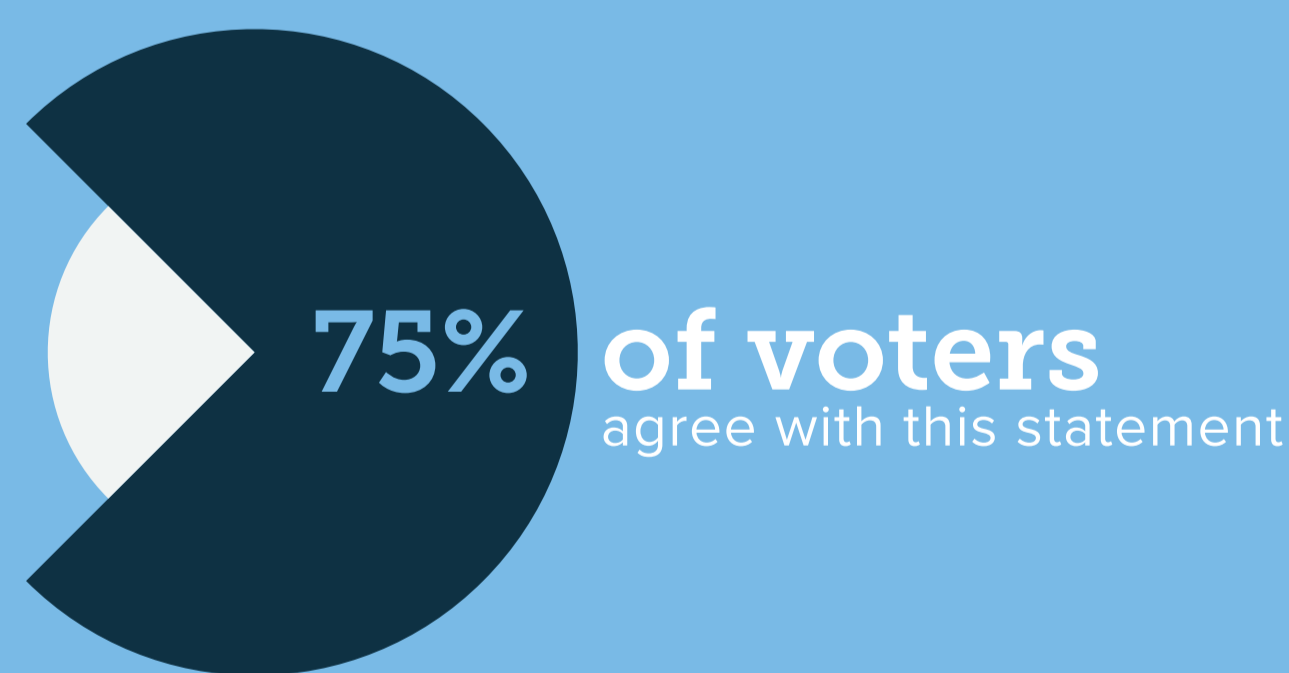

The Big Picture

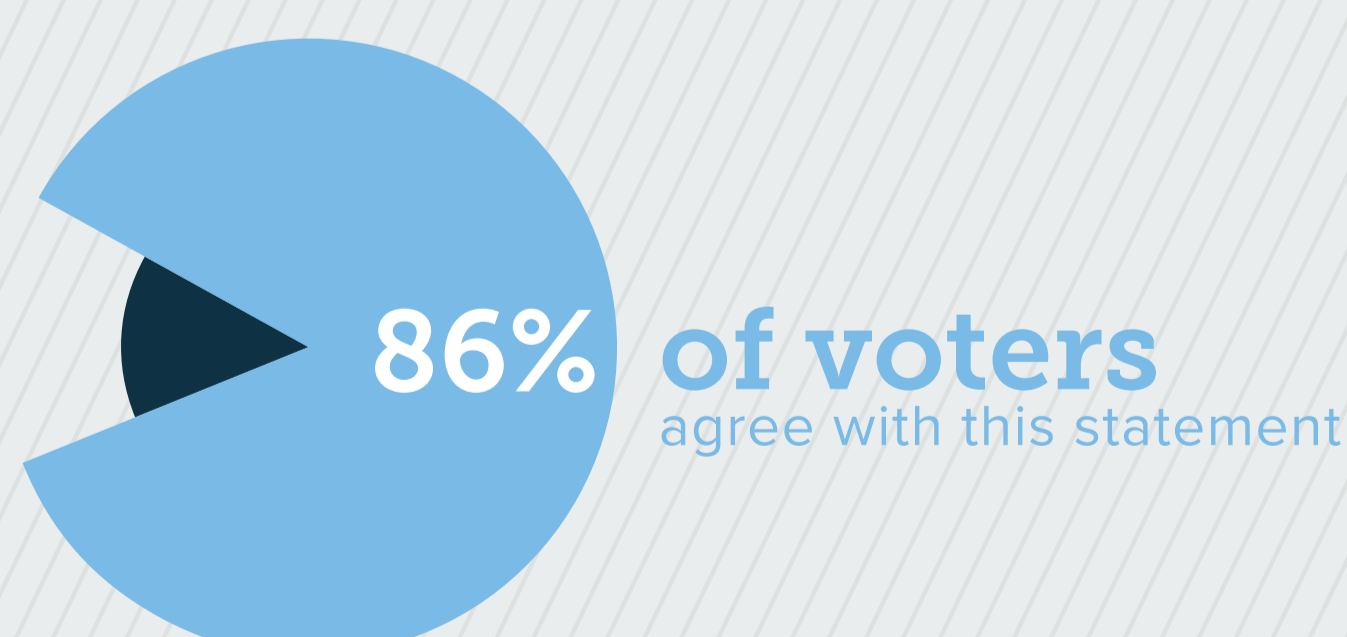
BUILDING EFFICIENCY
